Arthur T. Ross Scholarship	\$700	Completed Arthur T. Ross Scholarship Application stating career goals, past achievements, and financial need. Full-time SIU Automotive Technology major, three (3) letters of recommendation citing good citizenship.
Automotive Parts and Service Association of IL (APSA) and Ralph Silverman Memorial Scholarship	Four \$500	Completed APSA of IL Ralph Silverman Memorial Scholarship Application and is enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited Illinois college or university as a full-time undergraduate student in a curriculum leading to an automotive aftermarket related degree. Legal resident of Illinois. Preference is given to applicants with a letter of reference from a representative of an Illinois automotive aftermarket business.

For the following scholarships, completion of only one General Automotive Technology Scholarship Application is necessary. The one application applies to all of the following Scholarships:

Edward Wright Memorial Scholarship	Three \$1000	Completed application, SIU Automotive Technology major.
Dale Flener Scholarship	\$1000	Completed application, SIU Automotive Technology major in good standing; demonstrated scholastic ability; financial need; positive attitude; ability to work with peers; motivation to achieve and enthusiasm to learn. Preference given to a student from the Southern Illinois area.
Julian Davis Scholarship	\$2000	Completed application, SIU Automotive Technology major in good standing; hard working. Preference to someone who may have other non-financial barriers in life to overcome.
Mossie Oak Automotive Technology Scholarship	\$1500	Completed application, SIU Automotive Technology major in good standing; demonstrates a positive attitude; ability to work with peers; motivation to achieve and enthusiasm to learn.
Duncan and Wilma Lampman Scholarship	\$1500	Completed application, SIU Automotive Technology major who completed their first year of college at SIU in Automotive Technology, 3.0 overall GPA or higher, 3.5 GPA or higher in automotive courses, preference for those displaying financial need.
Jim Krudl Scholarship	\$1000	Completed application, Junior or Senior with SIU Automotive Technology major.
Neil Swartz Scholarship	Two \$1200	Completed application, SIU Automotive Technology major. Demonstrated financial need, preference given to cumulative GPA 3.0 or greater, preference given to female applicant or if not eligible an underrepresented minority.
James E. White Scholarship	Two \$1000	Completed application, full-time SIU Automotive Technology major in good standing who demonstrates a positive attitude, exceptional classroom attendance, and passion to learn. Mr. White led the program from 1975 to 1996.
Jack Greer Student Development Fund	\$500	Completed application, full-time SIU Automotive Technology major in good standing who demonstrates a positive attitude, exceptional classroom attendance, and passion to learn. Mr. Greer led the program from 1996 to 2010.
L. D. Willey Outstanding Student Award	\$500	Awarded to the outstanding Automotive Technology senior as selected by the Automotive Technology Faculty. Based upon attitude toward work; ability to work with peers; motivation to achieve; enthusiasm to learn; class attendance; GPA and Senior standing. Mr. Willey was the father of the program and chaired it from 1953-1975.
